3 // Binghamton, NY Today's festivities will take us to **Stonecrop Gardens**. We will tour the nearly 15 acre diverse collection of plants, water, grass, and rock gardens, and so much more! This historical location is truly a horticulturists dream.

4 // Geneva, NY Tour the magnificent **Corning Museum of Glass** to see the magic that is made when glassblowing artisans construct their delicate masterpieces! Enjoy **lunch** at the gorgeous **Belhurst Castle & Winery** before we set sail this afternoon on the Finger Lakes aboard the luxurious **Seneca Legacy** for a relaxing **cruise**.



5 // Rochester, NY Learn the history of the very first Women's Rights Convention at the **Women's Rights National Historical Park**. Learn the story of the struggles for civil rights, equality, and global struggles that continue today! Then, visit the estate of photography and film pioneer George Eastman, at the **Eastman Museum**. This institution houses unparalleled collections in the fields of photography, cinema, and technology. Then, in the afternoon we will tour the **Susan B. Anthony Home & Museum** for a glimpse of the iconic abolitionist and suffragist's life and history.

6 // Lockport, NY Don your ponchos and set sail aboard the **Maid of the Mist** for an up-close glimpse of the picturesque **Niagara Falls**. Hear the rush of the water and the spray from the falls as we sail up to the iconic waterfall. Just when you thought you couldn't see the falls any closer, we will ride an elevator 175 feet deep into the Niagara Gorge and follow your guide over a series of wooden walkways to the Famous "**Hurricane Deck**" and the **Cave of the Winds**. From here, you stand a mere 20 feet from the billowing torrents of Bridal Veil Falls.

7 // Cleveland, OH Local history is still very alive at **Lockport Locks & Erie Canal Cruises**, and has been experienced by almost a million people since its inception. Climb aboard for a relaxing & informative ride on the 19th-century engineering marvel which opened up the American Frontier. This afternoon, we will visit the **Made in America Store** to do a little bit of shopping from their 100% made in America collection of products!

8 // Troy, MI A **Ford Rouge Factory Tour** offers awe-inspiring encounters with America's celebrated manufacturing past, present and future, plus a look into the sheer scale of a working auto factory. Walk through the Legacy Gallery and Electric Vehicle Display, and look back at the iconic vehicles manufactured at

the Rouge complex, all while looking ahead to automaking's electric future. Spend the afternoon exploring **Greenfield Village**. This vast open-air museum will immerse you in the sights, sounds, and sensations of 300 years of American Life. Explore the shops and displays in the place where America's can-do spirit inspires you to go out and get it done.

9 // Fort Wayne, IN A vibrant exploration of genius in all its forms, the **Henry Ford Museum of American Innovation** allows you to experience the strides of America's greatest minds while fully immersing yourself in their stories. Step inside the bus where Rosa Parks took a stand by taking a seat. Play pilot as you explore flight innovations, or make yourself at home inside Buckminster Fuller's circular Dymaxion House. Then we will begin our **drive** back towards the midwest!

10 // Arnold, MO As we continue our ride back towards home, will stop for an unforgettable tour of **Hardy's Reindeer Ranch**. This 5-acre Christmas Tree farm is home to Reindeer which you will be able to meet up close! **Lunch** will be included at the ranch.
