- 4 // Hattiesburg, MS First we will visit the Lauren Rogers Museum of Art to peruse their gorgeous collection. Afterwards, we head out to Landrum's Homestead to explore the 30-acre living history museum. with over 85 buildings, exhibits, and displays showcasing life in Mississippi through the ages and have lunch there. If you are a fan of HGTV's show Hometown, you might recognize Laurel as also the home of Ben & Erin Napier. It is here that they live, film, and remodel houses for millions of viewers each season. Take a visit to Ben's Workshop, where we can see where some of their projects come together for the TV show. We will also have plenty of time to visit the town's revitalized downtown area and do some shopping at the amazing Laurel Mercantile Co. and many more! Lunch is included today.
- 5 // Biloxi, MS Hop aboard the coach for a guided bus tour of Laurel and catch a glimpse of some of Ben & Erin Napier's renovated homes.. Enjoy lunch together at Café Le Fleur, nestled right in the heart of downtown Laurel. After lunch, spend some free-time exploring and shopping in the revitalized downtown area. We will pay a visit to one of the most unique businesses in the area, Hellfighters USA Motorcycle Shop before dinner and the beginning of our two night stay in Biloxi.
- 6 // Biloxi, MS Today, we will take a ride on a Shrimping boat to learn about this vital industry. Take a 70-minute peek into how the journey begins for a shrimp and how it ends on your plate. In addition to a delicious lunch, the crew will entertain and educate while dropping a 16-foot trawl and dragging the bottom of the Mississippi Sound for all the delicacies she has to offer. Our guests are exposed to the spectacular world of sea life - caught on a genuine shrimping expedition. You'll also be able to take a tour of the beautiful Maritime Seafood Industry Museum. Finish the day with a guided tour of Biloxi.
