**1 // Anchorage, AK** Our adventure begins with a flight to Anchorage

**2 // Denali National Park, AK** Board the **Alaska Railway** for a breathtaking excursion into Alaska's interior. Spend the night in a lodge located on the outskirts of Denali National Park. **Lunch** is served on board. Tonight, enjoy a dinner with a side of laughter at Denali's **Cabin Nite Dinner Theatre**.

**3 // Anchorage, AK** Experience spectacular Alaskan beauty and adventure as we visit **Denali National Park** on a narrated half-day trip. Capture a grand view of North America's tallest peak, unspoiled landscape and wildlife. A box lunch is included.

**4 // Seward, AK** Board **Alaska Railway** bright and early this morning for one of the most scenic routes in the country as we travel toward the coast along **Turnagain Arm**. Dall Sheep graze on the cliffs to the right as Beluga whales surface on the cool water to the left, the mountains of the **Kenai Peninsula** looming in the distance. This afternoon, visit a local homestead and kennel and learn about their **Iditarod racing team**. Witness the power and excitement of these magnificent sled dogs and if we're lucky, cuddle some adorable puppies while we're at it.

**5 // Seward, AK** Embark on a day cruise to **Kenai Fjord National Park**. Experienced captains will

narrate the trip, as we glide past seals and whales while exploring coastal rainforests and tidewater glaciers. **Lunch** is served on board.

**6 // Anchorage, AK** Wildlife viewing is abundant today at the **Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center**. Surrounded by the breathtaking Chugach Mountain Range, a naturalist will share their expertise about animals native to Alaska. Board an **Aerial Tram** and enjoy breathtaking views, hanging glaciers and endless snow-capped peaks from the top of **Mt. Alyeska**. While here, enjoy **lunch** with a view. Gather with the group for a farewell **dinner**.

**7 // Overnight Flight** Explore Anchorage's history and distinctive downtown on a **trolley tour** this morning. Stop at **The Ulu Factory** to learn about the traditional knife adapted from ancient Eskimo craftsmen and the **Wild Berry Farm** for chocolates, wild berry jam, and smoked salmon baskets and gifts. After **lunch**, discover what people have been doing here for over a thousand years, surviving the harsh climate with ingenuity. Visit the **Alaska Native Heritage Center** for an appreciation of this fascinating culture. Then we'll head to the airport and catch an overnight flight.

**8 // Home** Arrive home today with countless cherished memories of our Alaskan Adventure!
