Enjoy lunch together followed by a historic airplane flight demonstration. (demonstration pending weather and plane mechanics) Enjoy dinner at the Grand Affairs with a nautical themed Mermaid Welcome Reception then complete the evening with a musical performance from the Original Rhondels. Day 6 // Ocean City, MD This morning we will tour the Nauticus and the National Maritime Center. This exciting science and technology center explores the power of the sea. Visit the Battleship USS Wisconsin, one of the largest Battleships ever built. You'll also learn about the port of Hampton Roads and the role it played in world maritime affairs is the high-tech, virtual reality museum.
