# IRISH ADVENTURE

SEPT. 9-19, 2024

See iconic sites of the Emerald Isle including Dublin, the Ruins of Glendalough, Blarney Castle, and so much more. The breathtaking views standing at the edge of the Cliffs of Moher and the Giant's Causeway will be unforgettable!

**1 // Overnight Flight** Depart for our **overnight flight to Dublin** to begin our Irish Adventure!

**2 // Dublin, IE** Today, we arrive in the beautiful city of Dublin where we'll check in to our hotel and get our bearings before the sightseeing begins tomorrow!

**3 // Dublin, IE** Set out on a **Dublin City Tour**. Highlights include 18th-century Georgian houses with brightly painted doors, tranquil parks, and historic O'Connell Street. Visit the **Custom House**, an architectural and historic gem built in 1791 on the Liffey quays, once Ireland's trade route to the world. In the evening, enjoy a drink with your group before **dinner** in your hotel.

**4 // Waterford, IE** Enjoy the delightful scenery of the **Wicklow Mountains** on the way to **Glendalough**. Explore the remains of one of the most important monastic sites in Ireland, founded by St. Kevin in the 6th century. Walk through the deep valley to view the picturesque ruins of a round tower, churches, and Celtic crosses. Head southeast to the **Dunbrody Famine Ship**, an authentic reproduction of an 1840s vessel that brought desperate Irish emigrants fleeing famine to the New World. Continue on to **Waterford** and take a stroll around the streets of this historic city with a local guide before **dinner**.

**5 // Killarney, IE** See skilled artisans create crystal masterpieces at the **House of Waterford Crystal**. Travel to **Cobh** for a **guided walking tour** - this harbor town was the last port of call for the Titanic in 1912 and was also the main point of embarkation for Irish emigrants between 1848 and 1960. Proceed on to **Blarney**, to visit **Blarney Castle** and kiss the famous "Stone of Eloquence" or explore the tranquil gardens. Journey west through rugged countryside to your hotel in beautiful County Kerry.

**6 // Killarney, IE** Discover Ireland's most popular scenic drive, the **Ring of Kerry**. In the beautiful Gap of Dunloe, stop off at Moriarty's for some shopping. Along the way, stop for **lunch**, take a stroll around Sneem, and stop at **Moll's Gap** to enjoy its panoramic views. Enjoy a **free evening in Killarney**, with time for dining independently and perhaps a visit to one of the town's many lively pubs.

**7 // Galway, IE** Head to the **Cliffs of Moher**, stunning formations that soar 700 feet above the churning Atlantic and extend for 9 miles. On the way, take a **ferry** across the **River Shannon Estuary** and travel along the scenic coast of County Clare. Take in the spectacular views as you walk atop the cliffs. Travel on through the austere beauty of **the Burren**, a distinctive limestone landscape formed by glaciers, to **Galway**. A local guide will join you for a brief

stroll through the medieval streets of this vibrant, artistic city.

**8 // Derry, NIR** Immerse yourself in traditional farm life during a visit to an authentic working farm, where you'll **watch trained sheepdogs round up mountain sheep**. Continue through the rugged mountainous landscape to **Donegal town** and enjoy some **free time**. Proceed on to **Derry**, where a **local guide** will help you discover this ancient walled city, long known for its tumultuous history but now a thriving artistic hub.

**9 // Dublin, IE** Explore the northern coastline and the **Giant's Causeway**, enormous hexagonal columns formed by volcanic activity over 60 million years ago. Visit **Titanic Belfast** and learn about the ill-fated ship through state-of-the-art displays. See the docks where the famous liner was built just over a century ago. Stop at the **Glyde Inn** for **dinner** with Irish specialties and entertainment featuring traditional Irish music.

**10 // Dublin, IE** Today the choice is yours. **Tour Dublin** independently on the Hop-On, Hop-Off bus. Use your voucher to visit one of Dublin's top attractions: **Teeling Whiskey Distillery**, **EPIC The Irish Emigration Museum**, or **GPO Museum**. In the evening, explore Dublin and maybe grab dinner on your own at one of the restaurants or pubs.

**11 // Home** Our Irish adventure comes to an end. Head to the airport for our **flight home!**
