ONE NIGHT STAY ON MACKINAC ISLAND

LILACS & LIGHTHOUSES

Explore the best the Great Lakes has to offer, including a one-night stay on Mackinac Island. Visit charming lighthouses, enjoy the summer blossoms, visit Upper Tahquamenon Falls State Park, and more on this 9-day getaway!

1 // **St. Louis, MO** Our journey north begins today. Travel across the Show Me State, eagerly anticipating our grand adventure. The Great Lakes are dotted with charming lighthouses and rolling waves, and our itinerary is filled with fun activities.

2 // Holland, MI Tour the magnificent and ornate Illinois State Capitol Building. See the refined renaissance style and learn the history of this 19th century government building. Grab lunch as a group, then board the Holland Princess for a relaxing boat tour on Lake Michigan with included dinner.

3 // **Traverse City, MI** Travel to the shores of Lake Michigan, where the picturesque community of Whitehall plays host to a number of historical gems including the unforgettable **White River Light Station.** Built in 1875, the



lighthouse contains artifacts of the Great Lakes origin and stories of the family that was responsible for the lighthouse. Take a thrilling **dune ride** among the unlikely and scenic Michigan dunes.

4 // St. Ignace, MI This morning begins with a drive past some of Charlevoix's iconic whimsical Mushroom Houses. These structures were built by native and legend Earl Young and look like something straight out of a fairytale. We'll also visit Castle Farms, where we will be treated to a special lunch and explore acres of gardens, discover dragons, and experience Michigan's largest outdoor model railroad. Another lighthouse begging to be explored awaits us at the Old Mackinac Point Lighthouse. This lighthouse serves as a monument to the area's shipping industry in the often fog-choked straits of Mackinac. Enjoy a delicious dinner as we eagerly await our visit to Mackinac Island tomorrow.

5 // Mackinac Island, MI The breathtaking beauty of Mackinac Island awaits us a short ferry ride away. The island's old fashioned atmosphere makes our visit peacefully quiet without the roar of motorized vehicles. Our time here begins with a carriage tour through luscious lilacs, and the colossal limestone formation, Arch Rock. Enjoy a delicious lunch at the beautiful and historic Grand Hotel and an afternoon of free time for shopping and exploring. Perhaps grab yourself some of the island's famous fudge for the ride back home. Then we will actually be lucky enough to enjoy a one-night stay on Mackinac Island tonight!

6 // Escanaba, MI This morning, return to the mainland and visit the Great Lakes Shipwreck Museum. Learn how closely connected the history of this region is to the seafaring way of life. After lunch, enter the Upper Tahquamenon Falls State Park, where the second largest waterfall east of the Mississippi roars in all its glory.
