

NOVA SCOTIA & PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND

Discover the endless natural beauty of Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, and Prince Edward Island as you dive into the culture and seaside beauty. Ferry rides and delectable seafood dinners will highlight this special adventure.

1 // **Bangor, ME** Our **flight** will arrive in New England where we'll have **dinner** together and settle into our hotel to prepare for tomorrow's adventure to begin!

2 // St. John, NB Today we venture "downeast" to Lubec, Maine where we'll cross the FDR International Bridge to beautiful Campobello Island. Turn your watch back 1 hour and then cross the border into the Canadian province of New Brunswick. Visit Roosevelt Campobello International Park, tour the 34-room "cottage" where the Roosevelt family lived in the early 1900s. Enjoy a box lunch on site and then switch your watch back to Atlantic Canada time to head to St. John, New Brunswick. Your kilted tour director will take you on a tour of the City including a stop at the Reversing Falls Skywalk. Have dinner together at a local restaurant before we retire for the evening at the Chateau St. John.

3 // Charlottetown, PEI Today see one of the Marine Wonders of the World as you travel through Fundy National Park to Hopewell Rocks to see the way the waves have created truly unique rock formations. This afternoon, depart for Prince Edward Island crossing over the world-famous Confederation Bridge. Take a brief tour of Charlottetown and then in the evening we'll have a traditional PEI lobster supper with chowder, mussels, and a one-pound lobster. Be sure to save some room for dessert though!

4 // Baddeck, NS Our first destination for the day will be to Prince Edward Island National Park. Take in the beauty of the white sand beaches, red sandstone cliffs and rolling dunes. Head to Anne's Land where you'll visit Green Gables, made famous by the classic Lucy Montgomery tale. Take a ferry through the Northumberland Strait and cross into Cape Breton. Alexander Graham Bell once said, "I have traveled around the globe. I have seen the Canadian and American Rockies, the Andes, the Alps and the Highlands of Scotland, but for simple beauty, Cape Breton outrivals them all." Dinner will be included this evening. 5 // Baddeck, NS This morning, visit the Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site to learn about his significant legacy and humanitarian accomplishments. Next, visit the Acadian community of Cheticamp, known for its "hooked crafts" and Acadian culture. The Cabot Trail winds around the rocky splendor of Cape Breton's northern shore, ascending the incredible plateaus of Cape Breton Highlands National Park. Have a box lunch as you travel through the park and be sure to have your camera ready!

6 // Halifax, NS Today, take a brief tour of Halifax that includes a short stop at the Halifax Citadel National Historic Site and a stroll through the Halifax Public Gardens. In the evening, enjoy a one-hour tour of Alexander Keith's Brewery as it was in 1863. Get a tour of the brewery and learn about the process from actors in period costume to bring the great Brew master himself alive in song and story. You'll have an opportunity to sample the beer before a relaxing dinner.

7 // St. John, NB Enjoy breakfast this morning in Peggy's Cove. This famous cove is a quaint fishing village where a graceful lighthouse sits atop the smooth wave-worn granite of the coast. The tiny harbor below the lighthouse is a masterpiece of seasoned fish sheds and colorful fishing boats, making it one of the most photographed places in Canada. Travel across the province to the Wolfville area, where you'll stop to pick up lunch on your own and enjoy in the peaceful setting. Travel through the fertile agricultural region of the Annapolis Valley, dotted with farms and orchards, to the port of Digby, Nova Scotia, the scallop fishing capital of the world. Arrive at the Digby dock for sailing aboard the Fundy Rose ferry from Digby NS to Saint John, New Brunswick.

8 // Bangor, ME Return to Maine and travel south through the blueberry barrens to Bar Harbor. You'll cross the causeway to Mt. Desert Island, home to Bar Harbor. Enjoy a free time for lunch on your own in Bar Harbor and time to
