1 // Des Moines, IA The cool journey north begins. Travel as far as Des Moines today and stop along the way for an included lunch.

2 // Lake Geneva, WI No trip to America's Dairyland is complete without a stop at Alp and Dell Cheese Store to stock up on cheese curds! Arrive in the beautiful resort city of Lake Geneva. A dazzling equine performance and dinner awaits us at Dancing Horses Theatre. Settle in for the first of our three night stay at the beautiful Harbor Shores on Lake Geneva.

3 // Lake Geneva, WI Awake refreshed for our first day in Lake Geneva. A local guide will join us for a city tour, sharing the history of the beautiful resort town. This morning, board a US Mailboat Tour for a one-of-a-kind marine experience! Cruise along the lake, as we watch the mail carrier hop off the boat, deliver mail, pick up outgoing mail, and reboard without the boat

stopping! We will stop for **lunch** at the historic and beautiful **Baker House** followed by a visit to the **Geneva Lake Museum**. This unique museum will transport you back to the mid 1800s where you can walk up the brick-paved street and step into the carefully constructed, period accurate homes and businesses! It's a museum like no other, and after you're done spend the evening exploring the rest of the town!

4 // Lake Geneva, WI Discover Racine, known for its marinas and Danish pastries. This morning, visit Wind Point Lighthouse, learn its history and take in the breathtaking views of Lake Michigan as you stroll the beautifully manicured grounds. Visit Lehmann's Bakery and grab Wisconsin's favorite flaky pastry known as the "Kringle". Then, return to Wisconsin of the late 19th century, when waves of immigrants came to America's heartland in search of a better life. Old World Wisconsin is

a living history museum featuring village shops, historic farms and heirloom gardens.

5 // Alton, IL Say farewell to Lake Geneva, and travel towards home. This evening, enjoy dinner at our host hotel.

6 // Columbia, MO The fun isn't over yet, we will stop and visit one of the midwest's most iconic landmarks, The St. Louis Arch. Take a tram ride to the very top for a breathtaking bird's eye view of the city. Later, visit the beautiful town of Hermann nestled on the banks of the Missouri River. This German town is a delightful stop and we'll get to "meat" the folks at one of its most prominent businesses. The old Hermann Wurst Haus is a deli extraordinaire and lunch is included here.
