# ALASKA'S NORTHERN LIGHTS

**This Alaskan adventure is one you will never forget! This small group tour is only for the most adventurous travelers and includes Anchorage, Northern Light Excursions, Dog Mushing, and exclusive optional excursions!**

**1 // Anchorage, AK** Your journey starts with our **flight into Anchorage**, a city on the edge of the snowcapped Chugach Mountains and 60 sparkling glaciers.

**2 // Anchorage, AK** Today, we'll embark on an incomparable **glacier cruise of Prince William Sound**, narrated by an expert guide. **Lunch** will be included on board. Blue skies collide with stark white glaciers, and playful otters dip in and out of the calm waters. Embrace the sheer magnitude of Alaska's natural beauty as you venture through a geological wonderland. In the evening, gather for a **welcome dinner** with the group.

**3 // Talkeetna, AK** Take a step into the past with a visit to **The Musk Ox Farm**. Learn about the Musk Ox Project - a sustainable domestication effort that has worked to preserve, protect, and increase awareness for these wooly creatures since 1954. Continue on to Talkeetna as Denali, North America's tallest mountain, looms large over the landscape. Check into the iconic **Talkeetna Alaskan Lodge**, perched on a ridge offering unforgettable views of Denali. Relax from the comfort of the gorgeous hotel, search for the Northern Lights from the Lodge's expansive deck, or enjoy some hot cocoa by the roaring great room fireplace. **\*Optional Excursion A is available for today.**



**4 // Fairbanks, AK** Begin the day with a presentation on Alaskan Lifestyle before hopping on **Alaska Railroad's Aurora Winter Train** for a full-day journey to Fairbanks. Sit back and relax as you are whisked away, through snow-covered mountains and striking valleys. **Dinner** is included in the train's dining car. This evening you arrive in Fairbanks, your home for the next three nights and one of the best places in Alaska to see the northern lights.

**5 // Fairbanks, AK** Enjoy a **full day at leisure in the city of Fairbanks**. Take this opportunity to relax or flex your sense of adventure with an optional excursion to the Arctic Circle. **\*Optional Excursion B is available for today.** Late this evening, chase the legendary northern lights, considered to be one of the most amazing natural spectacles in the world. Walk out in the snow under an unspoiled bed of stars and search for the shimmering hues of purple and green.

**6 // Fairbanks, AK** Look into the past at the **Antique Auto Museum**, where vintage cars sit between timely artifacts and fashionable designer dresses from times gone by. Hop in a car yourself, throw on some flapper accessories, and pose for a perfect souvenir snapshot. In the afternoon, embrace the Iditarod spirit and try your hand at **dog mushing**, stepping into a sled with an expert guide and gliding over the snow with your very own pack of sled dogs. Stay for **dinner** at the kennel owner's home and learn more about what the life of a musher is like. Later in the evening, we have another chance to spot the northern lights.

**7 // Overnight Flight** Enjoy a relaxing morning before heading to the **Museum of the North**, the University of Alaska's collection featuring 2.2 million years of biodiversity and thousands of years of human history. The remainder of your day is at leisure. A day room has been extended for your use before your transfer to the airport for an **overnight flight home**.

**8 // Home** Today we will arrive home after a spectacular Alaskan adventure.

**Optional Excursion A**

**Bird's Eye View \$300 / person**

Board a private plane and soar over the breathtaking landscapes of Denali. This excursion will last about 1.5 hours and you can enjoy the live commentary on board with headsets to hear your guide clearly as you fly over the mountains, peer into a dramatic gorge, and see sweeping ice-falls inaccessible by foot.

**Optional Excursion B**

**Arctic Circle Flyover \$550 / person**

Travel by air, just east of the gates of the Arctic National Park, where you'll view the rugged Brooks Mountain Range and tundra landscape. In Coldfoot, learn about the traditional people of the Yukon River Valley. Achieve the mark of a true Alaskan Explorer as you cross the Arctic Circle and receive an official Arctic Circle Adventure Certificate. This optional excursion lasts about 4 hours.
