1 // Amarillo, TX It's time to begin our colorful adventure. While the "Land of Enchantment" is on the horizon, our first stop is Amarillo, TX. Dinner is included tonight.

2 // **Albuquerque, NM** For more than 400 years, New Mexico has been a vibrant wine region containing a wide array of vineyards. Our first stop of the day is at **Casa Rondeña Winery.** This one-of-a-kind venue is located in Albuquerque's North Valley. Experience the spiritual and calm feeling, the manicured lawns, and the beauty of a fully-operational winery. Enjoy an included **lunch**, and **guided property tour** including the Animante de Rondeña Portal, Vault, Grand Room, Winery, Barrel Room and Founders Garden. We will then visit The Tasting Room to sample a flight of five fine wines made on the winery premises.

3 // Albuquerque, NM We will be up early this morning to witness dawn patrol and the mass ascension of hundreds of gorgeous balloons from around the world. Walk through the launch field and talk with pilots and their crews or enjoy a cup of coffee and a warm breakfast in the elite,

private **Chasers' Club** area. This afternoon we are joined by a local guide who will take us on a **city tour of Albuquerque**. Enjoy some free time in Old Town before heading back to the hotel for the night.

4 // Amarillo, TX After a good night's sleep we return early to the Albuquerque Balloon Fiesta field for our second opportunity to see the sky filled with wonderful shapes and colors in another mass ascension. We once again will have access to the private outdoor patio of the Chasers' Club area. It's not hard to see why this event draws so many people, from full time balloon chasers to first time spectators. We have to start for home, but not before visiting the Kwahadi Museum of the American Indian. Here we are not only treated to dinner, but we will learn a great deal and be honored with a dance performance designed to preserve and share the Kwahadi culture.
