**1 // Amarillo, TX** We'll begin our journey south towards Texas for our first day of travel. We'll settle in for a night in Amarillo.

**2 // Ruidoso, NM** Hit the road towards New Mexico today with an included **lunch** along the way. This afternoon we will pay a visit to the **Old Lincoln County Courthouse**. Lincoln is a town made famous by one of the most violent periods in New Mexico History. Walk in the footsteps of Billy the Kid, Pat Garrett, and other famous (and infamous) characters of the Wild West. Trace the events of 1878 through the courthouse and the Tunstall Store, with their preserved 19th-century atmosphere. Tonight we will be staying at the **MCM Elegante Lodge and Resort** for our overnight stay.

**3 // Tucson, AZ** Stop for **lunch** today at **La Posta De Mesilla**, where Billy the Kid was tried and sentenced for his crimes before escaping from Lincoln County. After our lunch we will

depart for the White Stallion Ranch where we will stay for the next two nights. We will enjoy **dinner** as a group at the Ranch.

**4 & 5 // Tucson, AZ** For the next couple of days we will enjoy a relaxing experience at the **White Stallion Ranch**, including an **optional horseback ride through the Sonoran Desert**. **Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are included both days**. Take your pick of any of the activities available on the ranch. Relax by the pool, play cards in the saloon, or just stroll the grounds to soak up the Arizona sun! There are also a number of **optional activities** available for purchase. Indulge in the onsite spa services, shop in their gift shop, shoot guns, archery, or rock climbing to name a few.

**6 // Tucson, AZ** Today we have a full day of adventuring in store. In the morning we depart for the **Arizona-Sonora Desert Museum**. In our exploration we will learn about the region on a **guided tour of the Mountain Woodland** where you may see some of the rich desert wildlife. See the agave and cactus gardens, and stop in to the Ironwood Gallery for the latest visual art exhibit and pay a visit to the Hummingbird Aviary. We will finish our visit with **lunch** before leaving the museum. This afternoon includes a visit to the **Presidio San Agustin del Tucson Museum**, founded in 1775 by the Spanish military. Enjoy a docent-led tour of the fort, explaining the history of this rich and culturally significant piece of American history. Enjoy **dinner** together before we check in at the **Desert Diamond Casino Resort** for the night.

**7 // Las Cruces, NM** This morning we depart for one of the most iconic locales of all of the historical southwest, **Tombstone**. Walk in the steps of Wyatt Earp and Doc Holiday and experience the historic town with a reenactment of the famous shootout at the OK Corral. Enjoy

lunch on your own in one of the great saloon-style restaurants. **Tour the Bird Cage Theatre**, which the New York Times reported as the wildest, wickedest night spot between Basin Street in New Orleans and the Barbary Coast of California. For 8 years from 1881 until 1889, the Bird Cage Theatre operated continuously, 24 hours a day 365 days a year. Legend has it that 26 people were killed in the theatre during its reputed years as a rough and tumble wild west saloon and over 140 bullet holes remain in the building.

**8 // Santa Rosa, NM** Today we'll begin our journey home, but not without a couple more fun stops along the way. Visit the **New Mexico Farm & Ranch Heritage Museum** and learn the amazing story of this bustling industry through interactive exhibits, demonstrations, and educational programs. We will also visit the mesmerizing **White Sands National Monument** to see the glistening white sands of the Tularosa Basin.

**9 // Home** Our adventure comes to a close today as we mosey on home, refreshed from our Southwestern getaway.
