1 // Overnight Flight Begin your vacation with an overnight flight to Zurich, Switzerland's largest cosmopolitan.

2 // Zurich, Switzerland Zurich's historic past blends seamlessly with its progressive futureall of which will be on full display during a Zurich city tour.

3 // Lake Lucerne, Switzerland Travel the scenic countryside arriving in the foothills of the majestic Swiss Alps. Lake Lucerne will capture your heart with stunning views of snow-capped peaks. Embark on a cruise across the tranquil waters of Lake Lucerne. Ascend a picturesque mountain on a cable car ride to the peak of Mount Rigi known as the "Queen of the Mountains." Take in breathtaking views of the city and surrounding landscape below. Later, check into your hotel.

4 // Lake Lucerne, Switzerland Discover Lake Lucerne's unrivaled beauty on a walking tour that includes the spectacular medieval walls and towers, dating back to the 13th century. Today allows plenty of free time to stroll through Lucerne's beautiful old town and explore on your own.

5 // Set Sail Before departing Lucerne, visit the iconic Lion Monument, then take a highlights tour of Basel, Switzerland's third largest city, learning about the medieval Town Hall and exquisite 18th century patrician homes. Board AmaWaterway's luxurious river cruise ship, AmaPrima, and settle into your stateroom preparing for an afternoon departure. Your accommodations include all gourmet meals while onboard. Regional wine, beer and soft drinks are complimentary with lunch and dinner. Also included, is your choice of daily shore excursions with English-speaking guides.

6 // Breisach, Germany Breisach is your gateway to several different excursions, depending on your interests. Step back in time with a **walking tour** of the enchanting Alsatian town of Colmar, which looks almost the same as it did in the 16th century. Alternatively, you may wish to go to Freiburg, founded in 1120 and home to the Freiburg's Münster, a Gothic cathedral said to have "the most beautiful spire on earth."

7// Strasbourg, France Strasbourg, the capital city of Alsace, offers flavors of both France and Germany because of its borderline location. Enjoy a **guided walking tour** past the stunning Parc de l'Orangerie, the European Parliament, the Place de la République, and through its iconic "La Petite France" district, which appears to have been lifted straight from the pages of a fairytale. Wander through these charming streets and past the Cathédrale de Nôtre Dame with its famous astronomical clock.

8 // Rüdesheim, Germany Ludwigshafen is your gateway to a choice of three excursions. Visit Heidelberg, the perfectly preserved medieval city nestled in the Neckar River Valley along Germany's Castle Road. For a more active adventure while in Heidelberg, join a guided hike up the Philosopher's Path, aptly named during the Romantic Period, and be rewarded with panoramic views of the city. Or ride your bike along the river Neckar to the medieval town of Ladenburg where you'll have some free time to explore the shops and quaint Marktplatz. Alternatively, you can visit one of Germany's oldest cities, Speyer, known for the largest Romanesque cathedral in Europe and the medieval Altpörtel, Old Gate. Later in the day, sail to Rüdesheim where you can visit Siegfried's Mechanical Musical Instrument Museum, or taste one of the town's special delights, Rüdesheimer Coffee, ceremoniously made with brandy.

9 // Lahnstein, Germany Your exploration of Rüdesheim continues with your choice of three excursions. Take a gondola ride to the Niederwalddenkmal Statue, where you can enjoy panoramic views of the river. Afterwards, indulge your taste buds with a sampling of Riesling wines in the vinevards. If you prefer a more active adventure, hike through Rüdesheim's vineyards, taking in views of the town, the Roman Bridge and Bromersburg Castle. Or join a guided bike ride through the town and along the Rhine River. During the afternoon, set sail along the scenic Rhine River Gorge with its fabled legends and many castles to Lahnstein where you'll enjoy a visit to Lahneck Castle.

10 // Düsseldorf, Germany For today's optional excursions, explore historic Düsseldorf with a
