

# **ICELAND ADVENTURE**

Embark on a spectacular tour of Iceland. The natural wonders and magnificent landscapes will mesmerize you! Experience epic waterfalls, pristine black sand beaches, gigantic glaciers and many opportunities to see the magical but elusive Northern Lights.

- 1 // Overnight Flight You're on your way to Iceland, a land and culture forged by fire and ice. Where steaming lava fields and massive glaciers sculpt mountains and valleys, leaving thundering waterfalls and plunging fjords. In this land of many natural wonders, enjoy the rare opportunity to search for the aurora borealis one of nature's most dazzling light displays, also known as the northern lights.
- 2 // Reykjavik, Iceland Your tour opens in Reykjavík, Iceland's capital city. Get acquainted with old town Revkiavík on a walking tour featuring the harbor, city hall, the Parliament building, and the nearby cathedral, dating back to 1796. Gather with your fellow travelers at a popular restaurant for dinner featuring Icelandic cuisine. This evening, take an exhilarating **northern lights cruise** and sail into the darkness of Faxaflói Bay in search of the aurora borealis.
- 3 // Vik, Iceland Travel the Golden Circle to experience renowned natural wonders, including the explosive Geysir geothermal area, the double-cascade Gullfoss waterfall, and



the famous Thingvellir National Park, where vou'll stand upon the crest of the Mid-Atlantic Ridge. Stop at the Lava Exhibition Center and delve into Iceland's past and present volcanic eruptions. Journey to Seljalandsfoss, one of Iceland's most famous and unique waterfalls before we continue to Vík. Drive out into the stillness of rural Iceland in search of the northern lights or venture out on foot. Enjoy three nights of searching to increase your likelihood of spotting

- 4 // Vik, Iceland Your day begins with a journey to Reynisfjara, a volcanic sand beach surrounded by basalt formations and rich bird life. Look out over the natural rock formations at Dyrhólaey, a volcanic peninsula towering over the ocean. Visit Skógar Museum and discover its turf-built homes and artifacts. Stand in awe before the impressive Skógafoss waterfall, one of Iceland's tallest. Cap off your day with a visit to Sólheimajökull Glacier, Iceland's fourth largest glacier. After dinner, gaze at the sky in search of the northern lights.
- 5 // Vik, Iceland Travel to Jökulsárlón glacial lagoon, filled with floating icebergs. Explore this extraordinary landscape and search for seals swimming in cold waters. After dinner, continue searching for the northern lights dancing across the night sky.
- 6 // Reykjavik, Iceland Drive along the south shore towards the Reykjanes Peninsula. Known for its rugged landscape, lava fields, and numerous hot springs, the peninsula is home to the Blue Lagoon. Take a dip in the warm, mineral-rich waters of the geothermal pool, located in the heart of a dramatic lava field. Return to Reykjavík for your farewell dinner and overnight stay.

Air Expectations for Iceland: Your air itinerary includes an overnight flight on Icelandair to get to Reykjavik. Passengers will receive a separate U.S. domestic ticket to get you to an Icelandair gateway where a 3-hour minimum connection time is required in order to claim baggage, and re-check into international flight. Flights into Iceland often arrive early in the morning. In-flight food/drink service on Icelandair may not be included as part of your ticket, but will be available for purchase. This group airline ticket is not available for upgrades and cost is included in the above pricing.
