- 2 // Rome, Italy Welcome to Rome, Italy's capital city, where centuries of history meet an evolving modern culture. Join your fellow travelers and toast to the start of an incredible journey during a welcome dinner paired with live musical entertainment.
- 3 // Rome, Italy Start your morning with a tour of the Vatican Museums and St. Peter's Basilica. Explore Papal palaces, halls and galleries housing priceless statuary from classical Greece and Rome. Admire the Gallery of Maps and works by great Renaissance masters such as Perugino, Botticelli, and Ghirlandaio. In the Sistine Chapel, marvel at Michelangelo's frescoed ceiling and brilliant Last Judgement. The afternoon is yours.
- 4 // Florence, Italy Say arrivederci to Rome with a panoramic tour of the 'Eternal City'. Discover famous sights such as the Baths of Caracalla, the legendary Aventine and Palatine hills, the ancient Circus Maximus, and views of the majestic Colosseum before traveling to Florence. You'll spend two nights in the "Cradle of the Renaissance," home to masterpieces of art and iconic symbols of centuries-old history.
- 5 // Florence, Italy On a full day walking tour, explore Florence, the legendary city of the Medici and the iconic Duomo. Enjoy a real-life history lesson as you discover the four pillars of city life: art, architecture, food, and fashion. You'll also visit the Galleria dell'Accademia, home to Michelangelo's David.

Perhaps you will take an optional gondola ride through the city's narrow waterways.

8 // Andermatt, Switzerland Travel north today, passing through the picturesque Italian Lake District – a holiday destination since Roman times, and pause in the lakeside city of Como, famous for its silk production. Crossing into Switzerland, traverse the heart of the Alps, taking in vistas of rugged mountains as far as the eye can see. Early this evening, arrive to the quaint village of Andermatt, nestled in the Ursern Valley.

During free time, seek out the renowned Lion Monument commemorating the heroic Swiss Guard or visit the Alpineum museum dedicated to alpine landscape paintings. Return to Andermatt in the late afternoon for an evening at leisure.
- 10 // Paris, France Travel through the pastoral landscapes of Switzerland to Zurich where you board the TGV France's high-speed train -

en route to Paris. Take in the scenery on your journey into France, passing gentle hills and verdant fields before arriving in the "City of Light". Famous for its world-renowned art, food, and fashion, Paris' captivating energy can be found around every corner. This evening, enjoy views of the Eiffel Tower as you gently float down the Seine River, tasting savory French cuisine on a dinner cruise.

11 // Paris, France See Paris at its best during a city tour featuring views of the endangered Notre Dame Cathedral, Arc de Triomphe, Champs-Élysées and more. Enjoy an afternoon on your own to explore Paris independently.

12 // London, England Say au revoir to Paris this morning as you board the high-speed Eurostar train. Relax in style as you're whisked away to London, England's sophisticated capital. Step back in time as you pull into St. Pancras railway station – a masterpiece of Victorian engineering. Transfer to your hotel, where you settle in for your 2-night stay in London.
