1 // Marshall, TX Our adventure south begins with a drive to Marshall, Texas for our overnight hotel stay.

Dive into the 200-year-old history of the property, the legacy of Marie Therese Coincoin and her ten Franco-African children with Claude Thomas Pierre Metoyer. Then, continue to New Orleans for the first of a **three-night stay**. Then, delve into the Southern history and beauty of New Orleans along the Mississippi River aboard the **Steamboat Natchez**. Enjoy captivating views, informative narrative, a delicious **dinner**, and live jazz music on the city's only authentic steam-powered paddle-wheeler.

3 // New Orleans, LA Begin the day with a behind-the-scenes tour and learn what goes into the making of the Mardi Gras parade floats at Mardi Gras World. Since 1947, the artists have been bringing Mardi Gras to life, creating many of the parade floats, from concept through

completion. The colors, lights, music, and "joie de vivre" are all in one magical place. Blues, crayfish, the French Quarter, cemeteries and a basilica...get a feel for the Big Easy on our **New Orleans city tour** this afternoon. We'll travel through three centuries of history and legends to discover everything from the outrageous colonial history and the Creole culture to piracy and oak trees draped in Spanish moss.
