**3** // Cody, WY Start the day with a self-guided tour at the Buffalo Bill Center for the West in Cody, Wyoming—a town founded by Buffalo Bill himself! The museum houses state-of-theart exhibits and authentic artifacts of the first international "superstar." Lunch is included at the center's cafe. This evening you're in for a real treat with The Cody Cattle Company Dinner Show. Enjoy a delicious meal and a foot-stompin live music show!

**4 // West Yellowstone, MT** Depart for Yellowstone, making a stop at the tiny outpost villages of **Cooke City and Silver Gate**, situated in the stunning valley between the park and the Beartooth Mountains. Once we arrive we'll take a **driving tour of the Upper Loop** to see the beautiful landscape!

**5** // West Yellowstone, MT Today we'll explore the amazing Yellowstone National Park. An experienced guide will lead us, and we'll make stops along the way to soak up the scenery and learn about the history and geological features of the park. Keep your eyes peeled for elk, bison, grizzly bears, wolves, bald eagles and mountain lions. Lunch in the park is included. Prepare to be captivated by the best-known geyser in the world as it erupts steam hundreds of feet into the air. **"Old Faithful"** earned it's name by being just that - you can almost set your watch by the eruptions that occur about every 90 minutes!

6 // Jackson Hole, WY Today we will head to majestic Wyoming to experience the Grand Teton National Park, best known for its magnificent 40-mile-long Teton Range, carved by glaciers millions of years ago. Enjoy lunch followed by a relaxing scenic raft trip through the impressive peaks of the Teton Range, spotting wildlife in their majestic and peaceful habitat.

7 // Riverton, WY We will get an early start today with a sunrise tour of Jackson Hole valley in Grand Teton National Park. Keep an eye out for the more than 100 types of wildflowers, 61 species of mammals, and 300 kinds of birds found in the park! With its peaks, valleys, forests, and wetlands you'll definitely want to bring your camera!

8 // Limon, CO Our journey back east begins today, but not before we make a stop at the Cheyenne Depot Museum, home to the last remaining grand railroad station on the transcontinental route, as well as the most powerful locomotives around! We continue to descend from the mountains and rest up for the night in Colorado.

**9** // Home Returning to the plains, we bring back new experiences and stories to share with loved ones, memories that will last a lifetime, and maybe even a souvenir or two.
