1 // Seattle, WA Catch a **flight** from Oklahoma City to Seattle, Washington where we'll settle into our hotel before setting sail tomorrow!

2 // Set Sail Set on Puget Sound in the shadow of Mt. Rainer, Seattle's stunning waterfront can be found curving past skyscrapers, historic neighborhoods, and the lush, rolling parks that give the city its green nickname. We'll catch a glimpse of the "Emerald City" on a **Seattle city tour** before we board the magnificent **Carnival Spirit** this afternoon!

3 // At Sea No port today! It's a great time to explore your ship and its exciting entertainment, food and activities! Take it easy at the pool, spa, or enjoy the scenery from the cruise decks.

4 // At Sea One of the most spectacular cruise destinations on earth, **Tracy Arm Fjord** is actually made up of two separate fjords. Each fjord is over 30 miles long, and a full fifth of their area is covered in ice, not to mention the glaciers, truly one of nature's most dramatic and breathtaking



sights. With the calving ice, hundreds of waterfalls and a variety of native wildlife, you won't even want to blink as you cruise through this natural wonder.

5 // Skagway, AK Gold seekers stamped to the Klondike more than 100 years ago and built Skagway, Alaska as their lawless outpost. Today, the town is more of a time capsule from the past, with carefully preserved buildings and streets brimming with history. Explore the **Klondike Gold Rush Historic District**, hit the rails on an **antique passenger train ride**, or fly by helicopter to experience the **ice fields by dog sled** on one of the optional shore excursions.

6 // Juneau, AK Astounding ice-capped mountains welcome the cruising traveler to Juneau. Alaska is called the Land of the Midnight Sun, and its capital shines with a wide selection of delicious dining and native Alaskan art shopping. With once-in-a-lifetime optional shore excursions that include **walking on glaciers**, **whale watching**, and **hikes** through the country's last old-growth forests.

7 // Ketchikan, AK For more than 100 years, Ketchikan, Alaska has been the gateway to the North. Check out the flourishing art scene and spectacular totem poles that have transformed this former frontier town into a popular southern Alaskan port of call. Optional Excursions today include a **Lumberjacking demonstration**, the **Totem Heritage Center**, or see the close-up views of the Sawyer Glaciers in the **Tracy Arm Wilderness Area**.

8 // Victoria, BC All the finest sights on Victoria are clustered around the Inner Harbour where you might choose to take a **guided tour**, or stroll the trim grounds of the **Parliament Buildings**.

9 // Home Arrive again at the docks of Seattle in time to depart the ship and catch our **flight home** from this unforgettable Alaskan adventure!
