The adventure seems endless when you're journeying to "the final frontier". This Alaskan adventure captures a glimpse of the most iconic destinations; Denali National Park, Glacier cruising in Kenai Fjord, and so much more!

1 // Fairbanks, AK The adventure begins with a flight to Fairbanks, Alaska.

2 // Fairbanks, AK Board the Riverboat **Discovery** for a cruise into the heart of Alaska. Learn about the rich native heritage at an unforgettable stop at the Chena Indian Village. After lunch, bundle up for a visit to the Ice Museum which showcases the unique talents of ice sculptures, as we watch them transform blocks of ice into intricate pieces of art. Enjoy an authentic Alaskan dinner with the group.

3 // Denali National Park, AK Strike it rich in the gold fields of Alaska on a tour at the Gold Dredge 8. You will be guided through the entire dredge as you see, touch and learn about the history that it contains and the dredge's importance to the development of Fairbanks. Our adventure leads us to **Denali National Park** on a beautiful route winding along the Tanana River. Check in to a lodge on the outskirts of the park for the first of a two-night stay. This evening, dinner is served with a side of laughter at Denali's Cabin Nite **Dinner Theatre.**

4 // Denali National Park, AK Experience spectacular Alaskan beauty and adventure as we visit Denali National Park on a narrated halfday trip. A box lunch is included as we capture a grand view of North America's tallest peak, unspoiled landscape and wildlife. A scenic stretch of snow-capped mountains and verdant green valleys give us plenty of photo opportunities, and our relaxed pace leaves time to breathe in that crisp, clean air. Tonight, gather for a delicious group **dinner**.

5 // Anchorage, AK On our way to Anchorage, we'll stop to explore the charming pioneer town of **Talkeetna** where the historic downtown features art galleries, boutiques and true Alaska charm. As the state's largest city, Anchorage encompasses natural wonders and metropolitan

6 // Anchorage, AK Hop on board a narrated trolley tour of downtown Anchorage. Learn about the history, culture and modern life as we pass by significant sites. Stop by the **Ulu Factory** to learn about the traditional knife adapted from ancient Eskimo craftsmen and one of Alaska's most noteworthy items. Feast on a hearty lunch before learning about Alaska native culture and traditions with a visit to Alaska Native Heritage

7 // Seward, AK All aboard the iconic Alaska Railroad for an early morning departure. The popular Coastal Classic route winds along Turnagain Arm and through the backcountry wilderness of the Kenai Peninsula, Spectacular views of massive glaciers and towering waterfalls can be captured from our seats in the glassdome rail cars. A full **breakfast** is served onboard the train. Upon reaching Seward, the train comes to a halt on the shores of Resurrection Bay. Seward is known as "Mile 0" on the Iditarod Trail, and this afternoon we'll visit a local homestead and **sled dog kennel** to learn more about the most demanding race on earth and cuddle some adorable pups.

8 // Seward, AK Embark on a Kenai Fjord National Park Cruise. Glide past seals, whales and puffins as we explore coastal rainforests,

tidewater glaciers and remote Alaskan islands. Your captain narrates the trip, so we will fully appreciate the beauty of the Kenai Fjords and the sea-life that abounds. **Lunch** is served onboard.

9 // Homer, AK Today, we travel the scenic route from Seward to Homer. First, stop at **Exit Glacier** Nature Center and walk the 1-mile loop for excellent views of Exit Glacier spilling down from Harding Icefield. Enjoy **lunch** in Kenai, a beautiful coastal town with Russian Orthodox influences. After lunch, we arrive at the enchanting town of Homer, nestled on the breathtaking Kachemak Bay. Our waterfront hotel is located at the end of Homer Spit - a long, narrow finger of land jutting 4.5 miles into Kachemak Bay.

10 // Homer, AK Today, Homer is yours to explore as you craft your own unique Alaskan adventure. Join your Village Travel Tour Director

on a Seldovia wildlife day cruise, or you may use this day to plan your very own adventure!

11 // Anchorage, AK Enjoy the scenery as we move through Turnagain Arm toward Anchorage. Wildlife viewing is abundant today as we visit the Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center. Surrounded by the breathtaking Chugach Mountain Range a naturalist will share their expertise about animals native to Alaska.

12 // Overnight Flight Relax this morning and savor your final few hours in Alaska, Gather for a delicious farewell **lunch** and visit the stunning Anchorage Botanical Garden before heading to the airport to catch your **overnight flight** home.

13 // Home Arrive home with cherished memories from an adventure-filled vacation exploring Alaska's Great Outdoors.
