1// Grand Island, NE Every year over a million Sandhill Cranes migrate through the Platte River Valley in Nebraska. This year we will get the rare chance to witness this wonder of nature together. Today, we will spend our afternoon at one of the largest living history museums in the Midwest, the Stuhr Museum where we will receive a presentation about the crane migration to prepare us for tomorrow's activities. A group dinner will be included this evening. Get some rest tonight, we have an early start tomorrow morning!

2 // Grand Island, NE This morning, we'll be waking up nice and early to get settled in our bird blind to watch the morning flights as the cranes take off. After the morning blind tour, we will load up in our bus as a step-on guide takes us out looking for cranes that glean for their breakfast among the farmer fields nearby.
