See the best of the charming history and beauty of Canada! Visit countless iconic landmarks like Niagara Falls, Notre Dame Cathedral Basilica, Quebec City, the Chateau Frontenac, and more on this gorgeous Canadian getaway.

1// St. Louis, MO Today we will set off eastward for our Canadian adventure with our eyes peeled for the iconic St. Louis skyline.

- **2** // Findlay, OH Continue our journey with more beautiful scenery as we pass through Illinois and Indiana, before settling into Findlay, Ohio for the night.
- 3 // Niagara Falls, ON We arrive in the Canadian province of Ontario early this afternoon and cross the Rainbow Bridge for our first view of Niagara Falls. We'll board a ship for a cruise to the base of the thundering Falls! At the end of our voyage, and a short tour of the city, we'll enjoy a special Welcome to Canada dinner.
- **4** // **Toronto, ON** This morning we will visit the spectacular **Skylon Tower** and board one of the "Yellow Bug" elevators for a ride to the observation deck 775 feet above the mighty Falls. Later, we'll follow the river to the 'Most Beautiful Small City', **Niagara-On-The-Lake**. Enjoy an included **lunch** before we stop to sample some of the fine wines produced here. Our late afternoon arrival in Toronto will give you a free evening to explore on your own.
- 5 // Toronto, ON Formerly known as "Hog Town": Toronto is now the financial and cultural



heart of Canada, as well as being one of the most multicultural cities in North America. This morning we'll take a **guided tour of the city**. In the afternoon, climb aboard for a **60-minute boat tour of Toronto Harbour**. Board our coach and transfer to the famed **CN Tower** and 360° restaurant for **dinner** while viewing the stunning surroundings from our dining room 1150 ft above the city.

- **6** // Ottawa, ON We'll start the day with a scenic journey along the shores of Lake Ontario, stopping in the picturesque city of Gananoque for an included lunch and an afternoon cruise in the spectacular 1000 Islands. The afternoon continues with a short journey north to the capital city, Ottawa. This evening, enjoy dinner on your own in one of the dozens of restaurants and cafes located within easy walking distance of your hotel.
- 7 // Ottawa, ON This morning we'll tour the city of Ottawa. Along the way we'll take time to visit Notre Dame Cathedral Basilica, the Parliament Buildings and Embassy Row. Enjoy free time at Byward Market, packed full of outdoor local vendors. This afternoon features a visit to the Museum of Civilization, where we will peruse the fascinating exhibits. After dinner, take the short two block walk to the Parliament buildings at dusk. Settle in for a spectacular Northern Lights-themed journey through Canada's history, which combines digital technology with the architectural splendor of the Parliament Buildings.
- 8 // Quebec City, QC Our journey today will take us through the Laurentian Mountains and the pastoral farming communities as we make our way toward Quebec City. Once we arrive, take a short tour through the old town portion of the city before retiring to our cozy boutique hotel for the night. This evening, explore the cobble stone streets of Quebec City and enjoy some fine French cuisine (on your own) in an authentic nearby restaurant, lounge, or street side café.

9 // Quebec City, QC This morning we'll take a guided tour of historic Quebec City including the Plains of Abraham, the famed Chateau Frontenac, the lower village and the Parliament Building. A special stop will be made to tour Notre Dame Cathedral. Next, we'll journey east for a guided tour of the St Anne de Beaupres Cathedral and Shrine. The afternoon continues with a visit to the spectacular Montmorency Falls and a short tour of Isle d' Orleans. Tonight relax and enjoy a special Quebecois dinner.

10 // Old Montreal, QC Today we will ride the rails as we board the modern VIA Rail Corridor Service between Quebec City and Montreal. In the late afternoon, we cross the St Lawrence River, heralding our arrival in Canada's second largest city, Montreal.

11 // Old Montreal, QC A beautiful morning lies ahead on a tour of Montreal. We will start with a guided tour of famed Notre Dame Basilica and then include Place d'Armes, City Hall, Montreal's famous underground and the magnificent St Joseph's Oratory. From the top of Mont Royale, we'll finish the tour with a spectacular view of Montreal and the St Lawrence River and Valley. The afternoon is free for shopping or exploring Montreal's many museums and galleries. Tonight, we'll have dinner in the finest restaurant in Old Montreal.
