2 // Revere, MA Your "Bean Town" tour begins with more than 250 years of history on a walking tour of Boston's Freedom Trail. The 2.5-mile red line leads to 16 nationally significant historic sites, each one an authentic treasure. Next, enjoy a tour of The Paul Revere House to see the home of the 18th century legend! Follow that up with a self-guided tour of Old



North Church, where two lanterns hung in the church's bell tower as an early warning about the coming British incursion. Enjoy a **dinner** together at a local favorite restaurant.

3 // Revere, MA You'll be fascinated to learn more about the city of Boston's famous history when we visit the Boston Tea Party Museum. You can be a part of the famous event that forever changed the course of American history through a multi-sensory experience that includes live actors, interactive exhibits, and full-scale replica 18th-century sailing vessels! Stop for lunch as a group and then we'll take a brief photo stop at the Bunker Hill Monument. Located in the historic Charlestown Navy Yard in Boston, "Old Ironsides," the world's oldest commissioned naval vessel, is still afloat and we will be lucky enough to step aboard. Then, visit the USS Constitution Museum, whose exhibits and artifacts offer a captivating journey into American maritime history.

4 // Revere, MA Today we'll begin with a self-guided tour of the Plimoth Patuxet Museum. In the oldest town in New England, Plimoth Patuxet is a vibrant cultural hub and resource. Discovering the past helps us to better understand our world. Here you'll explore the stories of the Wampanoag and English people who met along the historic New England shores. Lunch is included at the museum. Then take a self-guided tour of the replica Mayflower II
