1 // Claymont, DE Begin your adventure with a flight to Philadelphia, the City of Brotherly Love.

2 // Claymont, DE This morning, join a guide for a city tour of Philly to see where patriots walked in this historic city. The story of the U.S. comes alive as we visit pivotal sites of our country's birth. We'll grab a delicious lunch together at a local favorite restaurant. This afternoon, spend some time going deeper into the historical roots of the city at Independence Hall. The Declaration of Independence was signed here, the Second Continental Congress worked out details of our nation's political system, and George Washington was elected Commander in Chief under this roof.

3 // Claymont, DE Welcome to the world's premier horticultural display garden. Longwood Gardens, created by industrialist Pierre S. du Pont, spans 1,050 acres of gardens, woodlands, and meadows. It features 20 outdoor gardens, 20 indoor gardens within 4 acres of heated greenhouses, 11,000 different types of plants, and spectacular fountains. This afternoon, open a window to history and beauty at Winterthur

Museum & Gardens. Henry du Pont's house was designed to entertain, and the grand scale of the rooms here reflects the style of the times. The attached museum features a world-class collection of decorative arts, and the gardens are masterfully designed and maintained. Lunch is also served here.

4 // Niagara Falls, NY Travel north to the shores of Lake Ontario as beautiful Niagara Falls awaits. Niagara isn't just for honeymooners and barrel divers! Tonight, enjoy a delicious dinner.

5 // Niagara Falls, NY Venture to Lockport, whose namesake comes from a set of Erie Canal locks within the city. The canal was constructed over two hundred years ago and is a proud moment in U.S. history. Learn all about the Locks as well as the canal itself at the Erie Canal Discovery Center. Take a cruise down the Erie Canal and through two historic locks and see one of the original stone buildings from the 1800s. This afternoon, view the inspiring Niagara Falls from the Maid of the Mist and experience the rush that comes with the mighty thunder and scattering spray.

6 // Cleveland, OH This morning, enjoy a wild game safari guided bus tour over 2.2 miles of trails on 63 acres of land at the Hidden Valley Animal Adventure. You may also choose to purchase grain to feed and get up close and personal with some 350 animals representing 42 species from around the world. Or visit the Small Animal Adventure where you can walk among the smaller, friendly animals and newborns. Lunch will be included at the animal park. In the afternoon, we'll do a bit of shopping at the Made in America Store. Tour the facility and shop their huge supply of American-made goods, at this very unique store.

7 // Southfield, MI Henry Ford's dream to be self-sufficient in his manufacturing process was realized when the Rouge Factory started production in 1915. A city in itself, it has seen many transitions and is now a lean and flexible

manufacturing plant where the new Ford F-150s are assembled. Learn its history during a factory tour. This afternoon, make our way to Greenfield Village and experience 300 years of history as the sights, sounds and sensations of America's past come alive. Take a look inside Edison's laboratory, or go for a ride in an authentic Model T. From Main Street to Work Farms, Liberty Craftworks to Railroad Junction, this will be a fun-filled celebration of the American experience. Lunch will be included this afternoon.

8 // Indianapolis, IN Before we leave the area, we will make our way to the nostalgic Henry Ford Museum. Explore the museum this morning and learn more about American innovation.

9 // Columbia, MO Begin our journey home today, with a stop for a tour and lunch at a very interesting place along the way. Hardy's Reindeer Ranch was created over twenty years ago when Julie and Mark Hardy purchased their first two reindeer to help sell Christmas trees on their farm. After a few short years, the couple went to Alaska and purchased several more.
