

PACIFIC NORTHWEST

The great Northwest spreads out to the ocean, encompassing mountain ranges, charming atmospheres, lighthouses, and agriculture. See the grand scope of nature as well as the interesting culture that personifies the Pacific Northwest.

Day 1 // Seattle, WA Board a flight to Seattle and the beautiful West Coast where we'll begin our Pacific Northwest Adventure. A perfect way to start will be a short drive to the iconic Space Needle. We'll zoom to the top for a spectacular view of the city and the surrounding area including Elliot Bay and Puget Sound. We'll check in to our hotel and have a few minutes to freshen up before heading off to the waterfront for a welcome dinner.

Day 2 // Leavenworth, WA Take a city tour of the Seattle area this morning before stopping off at the eclectic Pikes Market Place. Watch out for flying salmon, and enjoy the flowers, crafts and culinary treats. In the early afternoon we'll leave the coast behind as we travel into the beautiful Cascade Mountains. We'll stop to view the spectacular 270-foot Snoqualmie Falls before heading into the rugged Snoqualmie Pass with views of the ski slopes and sparkling waters of Keechelus Lake. Our journey continues through the scenic and historic Blewett Pass until we arrive in the Alpine village of Leavenworth. Explore all through the main street and visit the world-famous Nutcracker Museum.



Day 3 // Mount Vernon, WA Today we will leave Leavenworth and slowly make our way to the North Cascade Scenic Byway. This is a route with massive mountain peaks, lakes colored azure-blue by the nearby glaciers and tumbling mountain streams. Along the way we'll view the fruit orchards of Wenatchee and beautiful Lake Chelan and stop in the tiny town of Cashmere to sample their famous Aplets & Cotlets. Follow the lush farmlands of the Skagit River Valley to the agricultural community of Mount Vernon and our accommodation for the night. Take some time to enjoy waterfront shops and galleries of the thriving artist colony and active fishing village of La Conner before settling in for a delightful **dinner**.

Day 4 // Portland, OR Our first stop will be in Tacoma at the LeMay Car Museum before continuing south to the newly renovated Mt St Helen's Interpretive Center. The center has beautiful new exhibits, and videos that tell the biological, geological and human story of the destructive volcanic eruption in 1980. Later in the afternoon we arrive in Portland, the "City of Roses" where we'll enjoy a delicious dinner.

Day 5 // Bend, OR A full day of sightseeing lies ahead today. We'll start the day by heading east, traveling along the original touring route through the city of Troutdale and stop at the iconic Vista House on Crown Point before reaching Multnomah Falls, the second highest waterfall in the nation. We'll continue along the Columbia River Gorge to the mighty Bonneville Locks and Dam where we'll learn about the navigational locks and view the amazing salmon ladders. Our afternoon journey will take us south to the bustling community of Bend for the night. Explore the charming downtown area on your own tonight!

Day 6 // Redding, CA Our Oregon adventure starts this morning with a scenic drive to the iconic Crater Lake National Park. This amazing sapphire blue lake was created by a volcanic mountain collapse. A lunch break will follow before continuing on into the Redwood Forests of sunny California.

Day 7 // Gold Beach, OR Today's adventure takes us into the Redwood Forest National Park, home of some of the world's tallest trees, some which stretch upwards of 350 ft. The afternoon includes a visit to the Trees of Mystery which offers an opportunity to glide through the forest on a gondola ride or walk on some of the amazing trails and suspension bridges

Day 8 // Newport, OR The shifting sand dunes of the coast offer an excellent opportunity for us to climb aboard a giant dune buggy for an exciting ride up and over the dunes and along the vast sandy beaches. This evening set sail for a leisurely Sea Life Cruise. Keep your eyes open for whales, porpoise, otters and a variety of marine waterfowl. Our exciting day ends with our arrival at our seaside accommodation.

Day 9 // Portland, OR Our journey continues along the coast of Oregon with a viewing of the Yaquina Head Lighthouse, Oregon's tallest lighthouse. We continue north, passing by historic seaside communities like Depo Bay and Lincoln City. Lunch is included in Tillamook, followed by a self-guided tour of one of Oregon's most famous dairies and cheese makers. End the day with a wine-tasting and a relaxing dinner cruise on the Willamette River.

Day 10 // Home Our remarkable scenic adventure comes to and end with our transfer to the Portland International Airport for our flight home.
