1 // Limon, CO Our journey commences! Head west toward the rugged Rocky Mountains where a nice **dinner** tonight is our reward.

2 // Grand Junction, CO Spend some time in the charming ski town of **Vail** this afternoon, where a scenic **Gondola ride** will give you a bird's-eye view of the mountains around you. This evening a group **dinner** will be a great way to unwind after another day of travel.

3 // Salt Lake City, UT Today we will visit the **Colorado National Monument**, where the towering monoliths and red rock canyons are a site to behold. Keep an eye out for the bighorn sheep that roam the rocky formations. **Lunch** this afternoon is included after we cross into the great state of Utah.

4 // Pocatello, ID This morning a **step-on guide** will join us and show us around some of the interesting points of Salt Lake City. No doubt you have heard of the **Mormon Tabernacle Choir**. There are daily organ recitals, a century-long tradition, on the massive pipe organ and we will get to listen to one before we leave town today. Spend tonight in Idyllic Idaho, the 43rd state of our great country.

5 // Twin Falls, ID Get ready for our quirkiest stop yet—an entire gallery dedicated to America's favorite vegetable...the potato! The

Idaho Potato Museum showcases the history of the potato and the revolution of the potato industry. Stop by the spud-themed gift shop and don't miss your chance to take a picture with the giant baked potato statue! And of course, enjoy a **lunch** at the museum cafe--can you guess their specialty? After having our fill of taters, we'll experience the post-volcanic terrain of the **Craters of the Moon National Monument and Preserve**. Explore the "lava tube" caves to keep cool, and witness the striking landforms created by volcanic eruptions.

6 // Boise, ID Shoshone Falls is often called the 'Niagara of the West' due to its size, standing at 212 feet high and 900 feet wide and it will be our first stop to make today. **The Sawtooth Scenic Byway** is named for the jagged mountain peaks and beautiful landscape of the area as we head toward the small town of Stanley for **lunch**. As we head back out of the mountains, we will travel on portions of the Ponderosa Pine & Wildlife Canyon Scenic Byway's as well.

7 // Grangeville, ID Boise, the capital of Idaho, is a bustling place, and a **step-on guide** this morning will show us around the city before we end up at the **Old Idaho Penitentiary**. Built in 1870, this territorial prison has seen its share of scandals and escapes, and will give you plenty to think on as we travel on this afternoon.

8 // Grangeville, ID Buckle up for a wild ride, because today we will be taking a **Hell's Canyon Jet Boat Tour** atop white water rapids! We will travel through the deepest parts of the canyon and see stunning gorge walls, local wildlife, and historical sites along the way. Yes, you will get wet! There will be an opportunity to swim in the Snake River during our **lunch** break to cool off from the summer sun...after all, how many people in the Midwest get to say they swam in Hell's Canyon?

9 // Coeur D'Alene, ID Visit the **Nez Perce National Historic Park** to learn about the resilient Nimiipuu people native to the area, then continue the journey westward! The small mountain towns we will pass today were settled by the miners as they searched for silver to make their fortunes. The entire historic downtown of **Wallace, ID** is on the National Register of Historic Places, and the local mayor declared it as 'The Center of the Universe'. This final evening of our tour we end with one of the highlights, a relaxing and elegant **dinner cruise on Lake Coeur D'Alene!**

10 // Home Experience a change of pace as our Idaho wilderness adventure reaches the riverside city of Spokane, WA. Board our **flight** back home after an idyllic vacation to remember.
