This turn of the century mansion, built high above the city, has spectacular views of the Mississippi, Lover's Leap, the historic city below, and contains many furnishings, fixtures and personal effects of the original family. Then we will visit a local restaurant for **lunch**. Next, experience **"The Life and Times of Mark Twain"** with a live show that conveys the spirit, wit, and fun-loving nature of the man that came to be known as "The Wild Humorist of The West." Return to the days of steam boating aboard the **Mark Twain Riverboat** for a **sightseeing cruise** featuring spectacular views of the Mississippi River, a scrumptious **dinner**, live musical entertainment and commentary on river history, legends and sights.
