**1** // **Amarillo, TX** It's time to begin our colorful adventure. While the "Land of Enchantment" is on the horizon, our first stop is Amarillo, TX. **Dinner** is included tonight.

2 // Albuquerque, NM Learn about Pueblo culture from ancient times to the present in the beautiful museum and exhibition galleries at the Indian Pueblo Cultural Center. Tour their collection of murals by Pueblo artists, enjoy lunch provided by the Indian Pueblo Kitchen, an innovative teaching kitchen and restaurant. Then shop at the Indian Pueblo Store for traditional and contemporary jewelry, pottery, rugs, and more from award-winning, internationally renowned artists as well as emerging talents.

3 // Albuquerque, NM We will be up early this morning to witness dawn patrol and the mass ascension of hundreds of gorgeous balloons from around the world. Walk through the launch field and talk with pilots and their crews or enjoy a cup of coffee and a warm breakfast in the elite, private Chasers' Club area. This afternoon we are joined by a local guide who will take us on a **city tour of Albuquerque**. Enjoy some free time in Old Town before heading back to the hotel for the night.

**4** // Amarillo, TX After a good night's sleep we return early to the Albuquerque Balloon Fiesta field for our second opportunity to see the sky filled with wonderful shapes and colors in another mass ascension. We once again will have access to the private outdoor patio of the Chasers' Club area. It's not hard to see why this event draws so many people, from full time balloon chasers to first time spectators. We have to start for home, but not before visiting the Kwahadi Museum of the American Indian. Here we are not only treated to dinner, but we will learn a great deal from the beautiful museum, designed to preserve and share the Kwahadi culture.

**5 // Home** Sadly, our fiesta is over, but the sights, sounds, and even tastes of the "Land of Enchantment" will linger.
