

WEST COAST WONDERS

Wander through some of the Wonders of the beautiful West Coast. Multomah Falls, Whale-watching in Coos Bay, Redwood National Park, Napa Valley, and so much more await you on this tour coast has to offer.

1 // Portland, OR 'Fly me to the moon' - or in our case, Portland, where we will begin our West Coast adventures. Multnomah Falls is an impressive spectacle as one of the tallest yearround waterfalls in the US and the most visited natural site in the Pacific Northwest. Dinner tonight will take you back to your youth as we dine at the popular McMenamin's Kennedy School.

2 // Coos Bay, OR This afternoon we will go on a whale-watching cruise. We can't promise you'll see these magnificent creatures out today, but we are going to enjoy our chance to get out on the ocean regardless. Later we will explore the sand dunes on a giant dune buggy tour.

3 // McKinleyville, CA A jet boat ride this morning is sure to put a smile on your face as we get back out on the water for this unique tour. This afternoon we drive through the iconic Redwood National Park, home to some of the tallest redwood trees in the world. The average age of the trees is 600 years old!

4 // Santa Rosa, CA The Sequoia Zoo is small, but its unique feature, the Redwood Skywalk, makes it worth a stop on our journey. Walk among the tree tops on the unique bridges that link some of the trees together and gain a different perspective of the grandeur of the Redwoods. We will travel on the **Avenue of the Giants** on our way to Santa Rosa this evening. We will drive through **Humboldt Redwoods State Park** which includes about 17,000 acres of old-growth redwood forests.

5 // Sacramento, CA You can't go through Napa Valley without visiting a winery, and we found a unique one for you. **Sterling Vineyards** is located on top of a hill and offers vistas you can see for miles. To get there, we ride one of their aerial gondolas to the top for a tour and wine tasting session. Following lunch in Napa, we resume our journey to Sacramento, where our riverside hotel for the next two nights awaits.

6 // Sacramento, CA The 'City of Trees' has so much to see. A Sacramento City Tour starts off our morning. This afternoon a step-on guide will take us around and give us the highlights of this bustling city. The California State Railroad Museum is one of the top museums in Sacramento and features restored engines and cars dating back to 1862 when the city's growth and prosperity relied heavily on the rail industry running along the coast. Dinner tonight is at the Delta King's Pilothouse Restaurant, aboard a beautiful docked riverboat.

7 // Carlson City, NV The California Zephyr train line is used by commuters and tourists alike, and we will use it to get to Reno, NV, where our bus will pick us up and take us to our evening dinner boat cruise on Lake Tahoe.

8 // Ely, NV A short stop at the Nevada State Capitol will start our day before we head to Virginia City. Starting out as a silver mining town, this community maintains its historic roots and you will have some free time to explore on your own this afternoon.

9 // Moab, UT Great Basin National Park is one of the lesser known parks and we will make a short stop here. Best known for its caves and hiking, we will check out the visitor center and learn more about the area. We have a good bit of driving to do today, but our reward will be the spectacular evening Sound and Light Jet Boat Tour after a delicious dinner.

10 // Gleenwood Springs, CO A guided tour through Arches National Park will start our day before we start working our way east. We will overnight in the well-known town of Glenwood Springs.

11 // Goodland, KS We have a lot of ground to cover today, but we will break it up with a stop at the Wings Over the Rockies Air & Space Museum. Historic aircrafts and exhibits about
