You'll find everything from hand-crafted decor to one-of-a-kind antiques while shopping in Shipshewana. Later, we'll indulge in an authentic Amish dinner at the Blue Gate Theatre. The show tonight is a performance of "A Simple Sanctuary". Based on the best-selling books by Beverly Lewis. It has a blend of humor, heart, and harmonies that make for an uplifting and entertaining evening at the theatre.

4 // Shipshewana, IN Travel off the beaten path, to an area traveled by buggies more than cars during an Amish Countryside Tour. This day will be jam-packed with fun as we visit a windchime maker, a rug weaver, get some tasty popcorn from Yoder Popcorn, and visit Long Lane Furniture to see the showroom of hand-crafted pieces. Enjoy an Amish Homestyle Lunch, then in the afternoon we'll visit a leather shop, do some shopping at the

Dutch Country Market, and Shipshewana Harness & Supplies. Some activities may be subject to change based on time & availability.

5 // St. Louis, MO Say farewell to Amish Country today and begin our journey home. First we'll make a stop at a Tiny Town with BIG Things! Check out the small town charm of Casey, Illinois; home to the world's largest collection of big things, with eight Guinness-certified titles for the largest objects. See the world's largest wind chime, rocking chair, mailbox, pitchfork, pencil, golf tee, wooden shoes, giant knitting needles & crochet hook, and much more.
