Enjoy a 9-day tour of some of the most classical Southern charm in the world in beautiful Savannah, Georgia and historic Charleston, South Carolina. The intoxicating beauty and atmosphere of this area are unlike any other!

1 // Sherwood, AR Hop aboard your premium motorcoach and begin the journey south with our first drive day. This afternoon, we'll stop in to visit the **United States Marshals Museum** to learn about the stories, history, and heroism of the often unseen work of the U.S. Marshals. Check into our hotel tonight in Sherwood, Arkansas.

2 // Morrow, GA Today we continue our journey with a second drive day until we finally arrive in Georgia. Settle into the old-world charm of the Peach State.

3 // Pooler, GA After arriving in the heart of Savannah, we'll meet our local guide at the **Savannah Visitor Center** to kick off an unforgettable afternoon. We'll enjoy a delicious buffet lunch at a local favorite, fueling up for an immersive trolley tour through one of America's most beautifully preserved cities. From cobblestone streets to moss-draped oaks, Savannah's charm is unmatched. Our day continues with a guided tour of the elegant **Andrew Low House Museum**, a stunning custom home designed by New York architect John Norris, rich with history and timeless Southern style.

4 // Pooler, GA Our morning begins with a scenic Atlantic Ocean Low Country Tour as we explore the outlying areas near **Tybee Island**, showcasing peaceful river inlets, marshes, and winding tidal creeks. We'll stop for photo opportunities at the historic **Tybee Lighthouse** before gathering for a group lunch at a local favorite. Next, we'll step back in time with a guided tour of **Old Fort Jackson**, one of Georgia's oldest brick fortifications. This memorable day ends with a two-hour **Riverboat Dinner Entertainment Cruise** along the Savannah River—an evening filled with great food, music, and beautiful waterfront views.

5 // Pooler, GA We will be venturing today to the **Golden Isles** of Georgia. First, we will begin with a Landmark Historic Tour of **Jekyll Island**. The **trolley tour** of the 240-acre historic district will be rich with the charm of this **Gilded Age Island** retreat. Have **lunch** together on the island before a Jekyll Island **Dolphin Watch Tour**. Next,

we'll transfer to **St. Simons Island** for a tour. Moss covered oaks and ocean breezes weave past and present together on **St. Simons Island** as your guide narrates delightful stories from the prehistoric geologic beginnings of these barrier islands, through the Colonial Era, the Plantation Era, the Civil War, the Timber Era, up to the elegant present-day Resort Era. A **seafood dinner** will be provided before returning to Savannah for the night.

6 // Charleston, SC Visit the **Charleston Tea Garden**, the only tea plantation in the United States, nestled on a peaceful sea island just outside historic **Charleston**. We'll explore the grounds, learn about the tea-making process, and enjoy an included lunch on-site. In the afternoon, we'll **tour McLeod Plantation**, where we'll gain a sobering and important understanding of the enslaved people whose forced labor created wealth for plantation owners. Afterward, we'll stop for a photo opportunity at the breathtaking Angel Oak Tree, estimated to be over 1,400 years old. We'll end the day with a relaxing group dinner this evening.

7 // Charleston, SC Enjoy a captivating **Charleston city tour**, where you're sure to be enchanted by stately homes, graceful gardens, and magnificent historic churches. As part of today's journey, we'll make a special visit to the beautifully preserved **Nathaniel Russell House**, followed by a stop at the iconic **St. Michael's Anglican Church**. We'll then continue to the **Joseph Manigault House**, considered one of the finest examples of Adamesque architecture in the country. After a full day of exploring Charleston's rich history and charm, we'll come together for a delicious **group dinner** this evening.

8 // Charleston, SC Get a taste of American maritime history with a visit to **Patriots Point**, one of the world's largest naval and maritime museums. Explore the legendary **USS Yorktown**, known as the "Fighting Lady" of World War II, step aboard the Destroyer Laffey, a veteran of the D-Day landings at Normandy, and experience the Vietnam Era Naval Support Base featuring Sea Cobra and Huey helicopters.
