2 // Nashville, TN Begin your day with a beloved local favorite for lunch, savoring Southern flavors and Nashville charm. Afterward, explore the iconic **Country Music Hall of Fame**, where the stories and sounds of legendary artists come to life. Next, pay your respects at the **9/11 Memorial** before ending the day with **dinner** at an iconic Times Square
