2 // London, England Arrive in London and begin exploring a city where history and modern life blend effortlessly. From royal traditions to vibrant neighborhoods, spend the day soaking in the pomp, pageantry, and energy of this iconic capital.

3 // London, England Join a Local Specialist this morning for a **tour of the iconic and unexpected highlights of London**, including **Big Ben**, the imposing **Houses of Parliament** and **Westminster Abbey**. Spend a leisurely afternoon shopping on **Carnaby Street**, consider visiting one of London's museums or wander along the Thames watching ambitious Londoners pound the pavements.

4 // Paris, France Say cheerio to London and hello sparkling **White Cliffs of Dover**, England's last hurrah before you **cross the English Channel by ferry bound for Calais**. 5 // Lucerne, Switzerland Embark on a **scenic outing with a knowledgeable local guide**, along the grand Champs-Élysées to see the **Arc de Triomphe**, honoring those who fought for France. See **Notre Dame Cathedral** and enjoy a stroll through the **Latin Quarter**. This afternoon, we'll take the fastest elevator in



Europe to the **Panoramic Observation Deck of Montparnasse Tower** for unbeatable views of all of the city's iconic monuments, including the Eiffel Tower. Then, we'll enjoy a **relaxing cruise on the River Seine**, discovering the wonders of Paris as we go.

6 // Venice, Italy Today, depart Paris and wind your way through the vineyard-covered landscapes of Auxerrois and Burgundy, journeying south past the 15 - century fortress of **Châteauneuf** and rolling green farmlands into Switzerland, bound for Lucerne. Cross





the famous **wooden Chapel Bridge** with its 17 -century paintings and view the mortally wounded lion hewn from rock, paying tribute to the hundreds of brave Swiss Guards who died defending Louis XVI.

7 // Venice, Italy Today's dramatic change in scenery is nothing short of remarkable. Journey through the Swiss Alps via the **St. Gotthard Tunnel**, crossing the border into Italy. Along the way, catch glimpses of northern Italy's stunning lakes, elegant retreats that have drawn aristocracy for centuries, before arriving in the enchanting city of Venice this afternoon.

8 // Florence, Italy Take to the water aboard a private **motorboat ride to the heart of Venice**



at **St. Mark's Square**. Admire iconic sights including the **Bridge of Sighs** and the ornate **Doge's Palace** before stepping inside one of the city's oldest **glassblowing workshops**. Watch skilled artisans transform molten glass into intricate works of art, a centuries-old tradition that continues to define Venetian craftsmanship. You may even wish to select a handcrafted piece as a keepsake of this memorable experience. Later, enjoy **free time to wander Venice's hidden calle and campi**, browse local shops, or simply absorb the atmosphere of the 'Queen of the Adriatic,' before crossing the Apennine Mountains en route to **Florence**, the 'Cradle of the Renaissance.'

9 //Rome, Italy Discover the heart of Florence on a **guided walking tour** with a Local Specialist. Admire the magnificent **Renaissance dome of Santa Maria del Fiore Cathedral and the Baptistery**, explore the city's

artistic and architectural treasures, and witness the craftsmanship of Florentine leatherwork firsthand. Stroll through **Piazza della Signoria** to take in its impressive piazzas and celebrated art before continuing on to **Rome**, your final stop of the day.

10 // Rome, Italy Enjoy a **sightseeing tour** that takes you past ancient sites to view the **Colosseum** and see the Roman Forum. Explore the Colosseum with a Local Specialist, where gladiators once fought before roaring crowds. Walk beneath its arches and hear how emperors used entertainment to unite the empire. After your visit, enjoy **dinner** at a local restaurant, sampling Roman specialties just steps from the city's ancient heart.
