1 // Boston, MA Board a plane to begin our **flight** towards the historical city of Boston Massachusetts! We will be here for the full trip so you can settle into your hotel room before the adventure truly begins tomorrow!

2 // Boston, MA Your "Bean Town" tour begins with more than 250 years of history on a **walking tour of Boston's Freedom Trail**. The 2.5-mile red line leads to 16 nationally significant historic sites, each one an authentic treasure. Next, enjoy a tour of **The Paul Revere House** to see the home of the 18th century legend! Follow that up with a **self-guided tour of Old North Church**, where two lanterns hung in the church's bell tower as an early warning about the coming British incursion. Enjoy a **dinner** together at a local favorite restaurant.

3 // Boston, MA You'll be fascinated to learn more about the city of Boston's famous history when we visit the **Boston Tea Party Museum**. You can be a part of the famous event that

forever changed the course of American history through a multi-sensory experience that includes live actors, interactive exhibits, and full-scale replica 18th-century sailing vessels! Stop for **lunch** as a group and then we'll take a brief photo stop at the **Bunker Hill Monument**. Located in the historic Charlestown Navy Yard in Boston, "**Old Ironsides**," the world's oldest commissioned naval vessel, is still afloat and we will be lucky enough to step aboard. Then, visit the **USS Constitution Museum**, whose exhibits and artifacts offer a captivating journey into American maritime history.

4 // Boston, MA Today we'll begin with a **self-guided tour of the Plimoth Patuxet Museum**. In the oldest town in New England, Plimoth Patuxet is a vibrant cultural hub and resource. Discovering the past helps us to better understand our world. Here you'll explore the stories of the Wampanoag and English people who met along the historic New England shores. **Lunch** is included at the museum. Then take a **self-guided tour of the replica Mayflower II** and enjoy a photo-op at the famed **Plymouth Rock**.

5 // Boston, MA On the penultimate day of our fascinating trip to the Northeast, we will start the day with a **self-guided tour of the John F. Kennedy Presidential Library & Museum**. The library and museum are dedicated to the memory of our nation's thirty-fifth president. Located on a ten-acre park, overlooking the sea that he loved and the city that launched him to greatness, the library stands as a vibrant tribute to the life and times of John F. Kennedy. Then as a final treat for our adventure, see the city from the water on a delightful **Boston Harbor cruise!**

6 // Boston, MA Step into Salem's storied past with a walk through the atmospheric Charter Street Burial Grounds, where history comes alive among centuries-old gravestones. Continue with a guided experience at the **Salem Witch Museum**, offering insight into the events that shaped the town. Afterward, enjoy **lunch** at a beloved local favorite before boarding a **trolley** for a narrated highlights **tour of the city's most iconic sights**. Following the tour, enjoy some **free time** on your own to explore Salem's shops, waterfront, and historic streets

7 // Boston, MA Enjoy a scenic day trip to Gloucester, Massachusetts, beginning with a visit to the dramatic **Hammond Castle**, perched high above the Atlantic with sweeping ocean views.
