2 // Louisville, KY Welcome to Kentucky! We'll stop for **lunch** at the **Derby Café** before enjoying a **guided tour of famous Churchill Downs**, home of the legendary Kentucky Derby. Explore the historic grounds, learn about the rich traditions of "The Most Exciting Two Minutes in Sports," and take in the atmosphere of one of the most celebrated horse racing venues in the world.

3 // Lexington, VA Today, we enjoy a scenic drive through the beautiful landscapes of the **Old Dominion**, taking in rolling countryside and charming small towns along the way. This evening, we'll arrive in historic **Lexington, Virginia**, where we'll relax and overnight.

4 // Glen Allen, VA This morning, we'll **tour Monticello**, the iconic hilltop home of Thomas Jefferson. beautifully preserved home and gardens. Finish the evening with a **group dinner** at one of Washington, D.C.'s well-known and beloved restaurants, celebrating a full day of discovery in the capital.
